Sundale Union Elementary School District to Hold a Public Hearing to Gather Input Regarding Proposed Trustee Area Map Adjustment

On January 11, 2022 at approximately 7:30 the Sundale Union Elementary School District will hold a public hearing at the District Board Room (13990 Ave 240, Tulare, CA) to receive community input on proposed trustee area map adjustment options.

The Sundale Union Elementary School District elects its board members using by-trustee area elections. In a by-trustee area election system, each trustee is required to reside within a defined trustee area and is elected only by voters in that trustee area. Upon the release of U.S. Decennial Census Data, school districts that use by-trustee area elections are required to evaluate whether the current trustee areas have approximately equal populations using the new census data. The District has hired professional demographers, SchoolWorks, to conduct a study of the 2020 Census data to determine whether the current trustee areas are population balanced. After evaluating the data, SchoolWorks has determined that the District will need to make slight adjustments to the current boundaries. SchoolWorks will present the findings of their study and present proposed map adjustment options for the Board and community to consider. SchoolWorks proposed map adjustment can be found at the District website. After this presentation, the Board will hold a public hearing to gather community input regarding the map adjustment option.
