

ANNUAL INVITATION FOR UPCCAA CONSTRUCTION BID LIST

Notice is hereby given that Sundale Union Elementary School District of Tulare County invites all contractors to be included on the District's UPCCAA construction bid list by submitting the following information:

- 1) contractor name and address where contractor may be contacted
- 2) telephone number where contractor may be contacted
- 3) facsimile number where contractor may be contacted
- 4) type of work (trade) that contractor is interested and currently licensed to perform
- 5) classification of contractor's license(s) held
- 6) contractor's license number(s) for each type of work and expiration date
- 7) email address of where contractor may be contacted
- 8) Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) registration number (compliance with SB 854 – see explanation below)

Please note, registering for UPCCAA projects does not meet any applicable District prequalification requirements.



Senate Bill 854, signed into law June 20, 2014, became effectively immediately. It established a new public works contractor registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

All contractors and subcontractors intending to bid or perform work on public works projects greater than \$1,000 will be required to register, and annually renew, online for the program. The cost to register for the program is currently \$300.00 and is non-refundable. This is a DIR fee paid to the State. The District will not register a contractor, nor collect funds.

No bid can be accepted nor any contract or subcontract entered into nor purchase order issued without proof that the contractor or subcontractor is registered with the DIR.

Public works refers to construction, alteration, demolition, installation, or repair work (including maintenance) done under contract and paid by public funds. For a more detailed explanation of public works projects, refer to California Labor Code 1720 -1720.6.
