- II. Approval of Agenda & Minutes from August Meeting: motion to approve Frankie Fralick, second by MacKenzie Souza
- III. Program Highlights
 - a. Educational Acronyms: Cindy Gist posted them online
 - b. LCAP Update: Nothing new. They are in the middle of getting new data, the goals stayed the same. Trying to get students back on track. Teachers are tutoring and checking in with students in regard to social and emotional status.
 - c. EL Update: Mackenzie Sousa presented. Finished initial testing for new incoming students and working on getting all students ready for end of the year test.
 - d. GATE Information: Cheryl Benson presented. 4th-8th graders- completed state testing. Students need 2 years qualifying ELA and Math scores three years above grade level starting second trimester, they will meet once a week and will have about 20 students
 - e. Social Emotional Surveys: Brooke Espindola- puts a survey out four times a year to the fourth through eight graders. The survey is nine questions long on how the kids are feeling. Then Eric Garcia and Brooke Espindola go through and check in with students that need extra follow ups.

- c. Reading Lab- end of the year star test showed 2 grade levels below 111 students tested

- d. Tutoring Information- Ms. Ashford is in charge. There are 6-7 students per group. We will be taking a break and then a new session will start after break. ELA and Math tutoring is after school
- e. Math Academy-6 weeks long. They meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Grades 1st through 3rd are together and grades 4th and 5th are together. Goes off star testing. 2 sections per year, 20 students in section one.
